Requirements for Membership:

Candidates for local membership must be approved by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors acts on membership applications at their regular meeting. Candidates must attend at least two general meetings of the Guild before submitting an application. At least one finished faceted stone done by the candidate must be submitted with the application. Gemstone will be returned after review.

Candidates for correspondent membership, who by virtue of distance, residence or other circumstances cannot regularly attend meetings, may waive the attendance and stone submittal requirements. Correspondent members shall be entitled to all the privileges of membership except the right to vote or hold office. Correspondent members are encouraged to submit a faceted stone of their own making, to be returned after review.

Membership Dues: \$25 per year; \$35 for a family. An engraved name badge is \$15 per person. Overseas and Canada rates: \$25 electronic, \$35 hard copy, per year. Rates are in US \$ or equivalent. All memberships include a subscription to *FACETS* (12 issues)¹
